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## COMMERCIAL CLAUSES

### 1 STATEMENT OF WORK

CRT - PRWRSM10094

#### FY09 REPAIRS A

The purpose of this project is to accomplish MARAD approved specific work items on the ship's approved business plan, as identified below. All completed work shall be in compliance with applicable standards as set forth in the Ship Manager contract at C.6.3, Compliance Documents, and Subparagraphs thereto, at the time of acceptance.

(Work Item List)

SR 484426 Inspect Diesel Oil Tks and Replace Fuel

Provide labor, materials and equipment to remove existing diesel fuel, clean and inspect the ships Diesel fuel tanks. Upon completion supply and deliver new fuel as specified.

SR 1104431 Flight Deck Control Booth Windows - Replace

Contractor to remove and replace the glass windows in the Flight Deck Control Booth which have delaminated. New Glass shall be equal to existing glass thickness and specifications and all workmanship and materials shall meet Current NAVAIR requirements as a minimum.

1103836 Troop Mess Room Ventilation, Noise Reduction

Furnish labor, materials and equipment to provide and install supply fan speed control capability and increase the supply ducting as per specification for optimized air delivery and noise control in the Troop Mess Room. All new equipment and installation shall meet ABS and USCG requirements.

4844162 Freezer Container -Trapped Man Safety Alarm

Contractor to install and alarm that will sound in the common area to alert ships crew if someone is trapped in a freezer.

4843536 Hatch Cover Repairs - Unsafe Wheels

Replace 50% of Main Deck Hatch Cover Wheel bushings, pins, washers, snap rings and grease fittings.

4844084 Ballast Tank Suction Line Replace -ABS Recommended

Contractor to scrap out and replace internal suction line for DB Water Ballast Tank 6 Port And 6 Stbd. Suction line is 4" Approx. 40 feet in each tank. New pipe to be schedule 80 shop primed black iron. All new steel to be coated in accordance with existing tank coating system. All work and materials will meet ABS requirements.

1103272 Unsanitary Troop Head Facilities - Refurbish

Furnish labor and equipment to complete repairs to Troop House head as per specification. Work to include new decking, bulkhead panels, urinals and complete refurbishment.

### 2 BAN TEXT MESSAGING WHILE DRIVING

#### CONTRACTOR POLICY TO BAN TEXT MESSAGING WHILE DRIVING

a) Definitions. The following definitions are intended to be consistent with the definitions in DOT Order 3902.10 and the E.O. For clarification purposes, they may expand upon the definitions in the E.O.

"Driving"-

(1) Means operating a motor vehicle on a roadway, including while temporarily stationary because of traffic, a traffic light, stop sign, or otherwise.

(2) It does not include being in your vehicle (with or without the motor running) in a location off the roadway where it is safe and legal to remain stationary.

"Text messaging" means reading from or entering data into any handheld or other electronic device, including for the purpose of short message service texting, e-mailing, instant messaging, obtaining navigational information, or engaging in any other form of electronic data retrieval or

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electronic data communication. (See definition in DOT Order 3902.10)

(b) In accordance with Executive Order 13513, Federal Leadership on Reducing Text Messaging While Driving, October 1,2009, and DOT Order 3902.10, Text Messaging While Driving, December 30,2009, contractors and subcontractors are encouraged to:

(1) Adopt and enforce workplace safety policies to decrease crashes caused by distracted drivers including policies to ban text messaging while driving--

(i) Company-owned or -rented vehicles or Government-owned, leased or rented vehicles; or

(ii) Privately-owned vehicles when on official Government business or when performing any work for or on behalf of the Government.

(2) Conduct workplace safety initiatives in a manner commensurate with the size of the business, such as-

(i) Establishment of new rules and programs or re-evaluation of existing programs to prohibit text messaging while driving; and

(ii) Education, awareness, and other outreach to employees about the safety risks associated with texting while driving.

( c) Subcontracts. The Contractor shall insert the substance of this clause, including this paragraph (c), in all subcontracts that exceed the micro-purchase threshold, other than subcontracts for the acquisition of commercially available off-the-shelf items.

(End of clause)
