SUBJ: INTERIM MESSAGE CHANGE TO USPACOMINST 3850.2K

RMKS/1. EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, CDR USPACOM DIRECTS IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW POLICIES AND PROCEDURES REGARDING THE BUDDY RULE WITHIN THE USPACOM AOR. THIS INTERIM MESSAGE CHANGE SUPERCEDES ALL PREVIOUS USPACOM BUDDY RULE POLICY PROVIDED IN REFS A AND B. ALL INFORMATION REGARDING THE BUDDY RULE AT REFS A THROUGH D WILL BE UPDATED IMMEDIATELY, TO REFLECT THESE NEW POLICIES. THIS MESSAGE APPLIES TO ALL DOD ELEMENTS AND PERSONNEL OPERATING IN THE USPACOM AOR UNDER THE FORCE PROTECTION RESPONSIBILITY OF CDR USPACOM.

2. REF (A) CHAPTER 4-2 IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

QUOTE

4-2. BUDDY RULE

- A. PERSONNEL TRAVELING THROUGHOUT THE USPACOM REGION ARE ROUTINELY SUBJECT TO VARIOUS CRIMINAL, TERRORIST, AND HOSTILE INTELLIGENCE THREATS. INDIVIDUALS TRAVELING AS PART OF A GROUP OR IN PAIRS MAY REDUCE THE RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH THESE THREATS.
- B. THE BUDDY RULE IS MANDATORY FOR TRAVEL TO CDR USPACOM TRAVEL RESTRICTED AREAS. SPECIFIC USPACOM FP MEASURES INCLUDE MANDATORY COMPLIANCE WITH THE BUDDY RULE.
- C. HQ USPACOM J02, CHIEF OF STAFF, MUST APPROVE TRAVEL TO CDR USPACOM TRAVEL RESTRICTED AREAS. SPECIFIC GUIDANCE IS PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 1, PARAGRAPHS 1-4D AND 1-4O. ADDITIONAL UPDATED GUIDANCE IS PROVIDED IN THE USPACOM MONTHLY ANTI-TERRORISM UPDATE MESSAGE AVAILABLE AT SIPRNET URL: [HTTP://WWW.HQ.PACOM.SMIL.MIL/13/134/](http://www.hq.pacom.smil.mil/13/134/).
- D. CDR USPACOM HAS IN EFFECT TWO ADDITIONAL CATEGORIES OF FP CON MEASURES FOR THE USPACOM AOR: DEPLOYED UNIT MEASURES AND INDIVIDUAL TRAVELER MEASURES. FOR TRAVEL IN ALL CDR USPACOM TRAVEL RESTRICTED AREAS, THE FOLLOWING USPACOM SPECIFIC FP CON MEASURES REQUIRE MANDATORY COMPLIANCE WITH THE BUDDY RULE.
- (1) DEPLOYED UNIT MEASURE BRAVO 11. IMPLEMENT THE BUDDY RULE FOR ALL PERSONNEL DEPARTING THE DEPLOYMENT LOCATION. REVIEW UNIT LIBERTY POLICY AND REVISE IT AS NECESSARY TO ENHANCE FORCE PROTECTION.
- (2) INDIVIDUAL TRAVELER MEASURE BRAVO 4. IMPLEMENT THE BUDDY RULE FOR ALL TRAVELERS, INCLUDING LEAVE AND TDY/TAD MISSIONS.
- E. THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR AN INDIVIDUAL TO SERVE AS A BUDDY CONSISTENT WITH THE BUDDY RULE INCLUDE:
- (1) THE BUDDY MAY BE A DOD EMPLOYEE, FAMILY MEMBER, OR A WELL-KNOWN AND TRUSTED CIVILIAN ACQUAINTANCE (E.G., CO-WORKER OR CLOSE FRIEND). WHILE PREFERRED AND ENCOURAGED, THE BUDDY DOES NOT HAVE TO BE A MEMBER OF DOD.
- (2) THE BUDDY MAY ALSO BE A PERSON ALREADY IN THE COUNTRY, SUCH AS A WELL-KNOWN FOREIGN NATIONAL OR A TRUSTED HOST NATION POINT OF

CONTACT.

(3) A CASUAL ACQUAINTANCE IS SOMEONE YOU DO NOT KNOW WELL AND DOES NOT QUALIFY AS A BUDDY.

F. BUDDY RESPONSIBILITIES

(1) A BUDDY MUST BE AVAILABLE TO ACCOMPANY THE TRAVELER DURING ALL TRAVEL OUTSIDE OF A SECURE LOCATION (E.G., HOTEL, AMEMBASSY, CAMP, ETC.).

(2) A BUDDY MUST MEET THE REQUIREMENTS IN PARA 4-2E ABOVE.

G. INDIVIDUAL TRAVELER RESPONSIBILITIES

(1) YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR SELECTING A BUDDY MEETING THE QUALIFICATIONS IN PARA 4-2E ABOVE.

(2) YOUR FP PLANS MUST INDICATE THAT YOU HAVE SELECTED A QUALIFIED BUDDY AND IDENTIFY THAT THE BUDDY SELECTED MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS IN PARA 4-2E ABOVE.

(3) IF YOU ARE AN INDIVIDUAL TRAVELER OR CONDUCTING INDIVIDUAL MOVEMENT TO JOIN A DEPLOYED UNIT, VIA AIRCRAFT, YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO TRAVEL WITH A BUDDY, WHILE ENROUTE TO A CDR USPACOM TRAVEL RESTRICTED AREA.

(4) AFTER ARRIVAL IN A CDR USPACOM TRAVEL RESTRICTED AREA, ALL TRAVEL (GROUND, AIR, ETC) MUST BE ACCOMPLISHED WITH A BUDDY MEETING THE QUALIFICATIONS SPECIFIED IN PARA 4-2E ABOVE.

(5) YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO USE A BUDDY WHEN YOUR TRAVEL IS EXCLUSIVELY INSIDE A SECURE LOCATION (E.G., HOTEL, AMEMBASSY, CAMP, ETC.).

(6) YOU MUST USE A BUDDY WHEN YOU TRAVEL OUTSIDE OF A SECURE LOCATION (E.G., HOTEL, EMBASSY, CAMP, ETC)

H. COMMANDERS OF A DEPLOYED UNIT REQUIREMENTS

(1) COMMANDERS WILL INCLUDE IN DEPLOYED UNIT FP PLANS, SPECIFIC GUIDANCE TO ALL PERSONNEL REGARDING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE BUDDY RULE.

(2) COMMANDERS WILL ENSURE THAT UPON ARRIVAL ALL DEPLOYED PERSONNEL TRAVELING OUTSIDE OF A SECURE LOCATION (E.G., HOTEL, EMBASSY, CAMP, ETC) TRAVEL IN PAIRS.

I. WAIVER REQUEST REQUIREMENTS

(1) COMMANDERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR INITIATING WAIVER REQUESTS TO FPCON MEASURES REQUIRING THE BUDDY RULE AS DEEMED APPROPRIATE.

(2) COMMANDERS MUST PURSUE APPROVAL OF A WAIVER TO SPECIFIC FPCON MEASURES BY THE FIRST GENERAL/FLAG OFFICER, OR DOD CIVILIAN MEMBER OF THE SENIOR EXECUTIVE SERVICE (SES) EXERCISING EQUIVALENT AUTHORITY IN THE CHAIN OF COMMAND, WHO HAS TACON FOR FORCE PROTECTION AS STATED IN PARAGRAPH 2-6A.

(3) IF THE FO/GO/SES, APPROVES THE WAIVER, THE MESSAGE REQUESTING AN EXCEPTION TO CDR USPACOM TRAVEL RESTRICTION POLICY MUST PROVIDE A JUSTIFICATION EXPLAINING WHY THE FPCON MEASURES REQUIRING THE BUDDY RULE ARE BEING WAIVED.

(4) SPECIFIC GUIDANCE FOR REQUESTING AN EXCEPTION TO CDR USPACOM TRAVEL RESTRICTION POLICY AND THEATER TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS ARE
