

SECTION C -- DESCRIPTIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

C.1 STATEMENT OF WORK

STATEMENT OF WORK Item 1.

Ship Manager Nautical System 5 (NS5) Data Extraction Tool.

As used in this SOW, the term "ship manager" includes the two (2) databases that are operated by MARAD's Logistics Support Contractor.

The contractor will provide a software application which translates the site's (ship manager or logistics contractor site specific) NS5 database into a simplified data structure for use by ship managers in developing reports. Basic flow of the application should be as follows:

- ◊ Extract Data from the 40+ purchasing tables in NS5
- ◊ Assemble the data from NS5 into a Reporting Application Database for ease of use in the generation of reports. This simplified schema will include all elements necessary to generate reports used in the conduct of day-to-day business by the ship managers. This schema will include all project-related data for each and every purchase transaction, including line items.
- ◊ The application shall both run on demand, or via a scheduler, in order to provide an update to the data resident in the reporting database.

The following specific business rules relate to this application:

- ◊ Application shall only extract and assemble data from the projects/vendors/purchases under the cognizance of the ship manager. The application will not allow any ship manager the access to view or edit projects, RFQs, and Vendors of any other ship manager.
- ◊ Application shall not expose in any form or fashion the plain text version of the database access password. (ODBC password).
- ◊ The application shall not write to or edit the production database that any ship manager currently has.
- ◊ Any components used by the application for data transformation services must be secured in such a way as to prevent unauthorized access to production data.
- ◊ Application must be compatible with the current Windows operating platform environment that the ship manager currently has.

Within THIRTY (30) days of contract award, the contractor shall provide the following deliverables in electronic format for the data extraction application:

- ◊ Application executables
- ◊ Blank database file (SQL Server)
- ◊ User's Manual (including Database Schema)
- ◊ Installation Routine
- ◊ Data Dictionary outlining the schema for the database, defining each data element, and defining the relationships between each table/element (Note: This information may be included in the User's Manual).

The contractor is solely responsible for quality assurance testing of the product and of subsequent releases.

MARAD is granted a license to the executable binaries for use by the current ship managers and any new ship managers awarded contracts by MARAD within the period of performance of this contract. Ship Managers shall be entitled to use the application only on their copy of the MARAD NS5 database.

Source code for the application will be provided to MARAD in the event that the contractor chooses to, or is not able to, provide maintenance of the application. In accordance with the authority of FAR Part 52.227-14 (Alternate III), the government is able to require the delivery of the source code to the data extraction tool which is restricted computer software rather than allow the contractor to withhold such restricted computer software. To obtain this delivery of the restricted computer software, the Contracting Officer shall -

- (i) Identify and specify the deliverable computer software in the contract; or
- (ii) Require by written request during contract performance, the delivery of computer software source code that has been withheld or identified to be withheld under paragraph (g)(1) of the clause.

STATEMENT OF WORK Item 2.

Installation and Training Assistance.

The contractor will provide software installation setup assistance and training for two days at each ship manager site in support of the reporting application of the Data Extraction Tool. This on-site support will include the following:

- ◊ Assisting the ship manager's IT staff in the installation of the application in the ship manager environment.
- ◊ Configuration of the database and application scheduling in the ship manager environment.
- ◊ Training of the staff at ship manager's site in usage of the application and how to develop reports from the database.
- ◊ The contractor is not required to develop reports for ship managers.
- ◊ User support is included during the time period when the installations are being performed until superseded by CLIN 0003.

Within TWENTY (20) days of contract award, the contractor will submit a travel schedule for MARAD approval. Unless authorized in advance by MARAD, on-site visits will be concluded within 120 days of contract award. For planning purposes, the following is a tentative list of sites to be visited:

Follow-on Support.

Ship managers will document and report problems encountered with the application to the MARAD RMS Helpdesk (RMS@dot.gov). The contractor will provide second-tier technical support to resolve data or procedural issues that cannot be resolved by the Helpdesk. The contractor will provide an e-mail address and phone number (if different from the contractor's normal business phone number(s)) to support submission of technical support requests by the Helpdesk. Within TWO (2) business days of receiving a request, the contractor will either resolve the issue or inform the MARAD RMS Helpdesk of the projected timeframe for resolution. In the event an issue cannot be resolved within TEN (10) working days, the contractor will advise the COTR in writing and provide the specific cause(s) for the delay and a detailed plan of action for doing so. In all instances, the contractor will inform the MARAD RMS Helpdesk when the issue has been resolved.

MARAD reserves the right to deduct up to a total of half (½) portion of the monthly maintenance fee in the event the contractor's efforts in resolving support issues are determined to be unsatisfactory. However, such deduction shall be in addition to any other rights under this contract.

The contractor is responsible for maintaining the application's compatibility with the latest release of NS5 being used by MARAD. The contractor will also maintain and provide an updated Data Dictionary, and User's Manual to reflect NS5 changes that impact the reporting database.

Software Release Notes for subsequent versions are to be provided concurrent with the associated software release.

On an annual basis, MARAD will evaluate contractor performance prior to exercising the option for maintenance. Unsatisfactory performance may result in renegotiating or cancelling follow-on maintenance support.
