Statement of Work

Purpose: to outfit the dormitory rooms in Murphy Hall with new furniture before the start of the new academic year, 25 July 2010.

The Contractor will provide all the labor, equipment, storage space, miscellaneous parts and rubbish removal needed to accomplish the following:

- a. Disassemble approximately 50 sets of Dehler dormitory furniture (loft systems) currently located in Rogers and Cleveland Halls. These sets of furniture consist of the following: a bed unit (includes a separate ladder), dressers, a mattress and a wardrobe. Move all the disassembled units to Murphy Hall. Place the disassembled units in Murphy Hall dorm rooms and then reassemble units. The chairs necessary to complete the installation will come from an offsite warehouse in New Jersey.
- b. Remove all the dorm furniture stored at an offsite warehouse in New Jersey and bring it to Murphy Hall, US Merchant Marine Academy, Kings Point, NY. Once on site assemble the loft systems in their assigned rooms.
- c. Contractor must remove all trash.
- d. Contractor is not allowed to drive trucks over the newly renovated Barney Square. All vehicular traffic must travel around the perimeter of the academy's dorm complex.
- e. Contractor will take care to insure that floors, walls and stairwells are protected. Murphy Hall is a newly renovated building.
- f. Start date: TBA, subject to USMMA obtaining beneficial occupancy or outright control of the building.
