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1 STATEMENT OF WORK

FSS BOILER DEHUMIDIFICATION SYSTEM SURVEY FOR INSTALLATION

1.0 INTENT

The intent of this specification is to define the vessel equipment survey and development of requirement specifications for installation of a Dehumidification System serving the firesides and watersides of each FSS vessel's two (2) Foster Wheeler main propulsion boilers including a monitoring system.

2.1 Foster Wheeler Instruction Manual

3.0 LOCATION

USNS Bellatrix - Violet Dock Port, Violet, La.

4.0 OFE/OFM

4.1 As listed in 2.1

5.0 WORK STATEMENT

The Contractor is to provide all necessary labor and equipment to accomplish a dehumidification system requirement survey and develop a detailed description for a dedicated Dehumidification System(s) that would independently preserve the waterside and fireside of the vessel's boiler while the vessel is in ROS status. The Dehumidification System shall include detail all the necessary dehumidification equipment, ductwork, airflow indicators and sensors, control and monitoring systems as required for a complete system.

The following equipment will be surveyed for the integration of a dehumidification system(s) as required:

1. Waterside of Boiler and all associated components
2. Fireside of Boiler and all associated components
3. SSTG and their reduction gears
4. Main engine, HP & LP
5. Associated Feed Pumps

Fundamentally, the system shall be computer controlled and monitored, be a permanent Marine installation, yet easily commissioned and decommissioned, and shall be designed to have independent Dehumidification Machines serving each of the boiler firesides and watersides utilizing the appropriate number and CFM rating for each.

6.0 PERFORMANCE CRITERIA/DELIVERABLES

6.1 Contractor to furnish five (5) copies of detailed DH system and monitoring/control survey, including a cost estimate and Bill of Materials required per 5.0 Work Statement.

7.0 NOTES

The required survey will be accomplished aboard the vessel USNS Bellatrix, presently undergoing a complete retubing of the Port and Stbd boilers.

(a)(1) The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code for this acquisition is 238220.

(2) The small business size standard is 13 million.

(3) The small business size standard for a concern which submits an offer in its own name, other than on a construction or service contract, but which proposes to furnish a product which it did not itself manufacture, is 500 employees.

(b) Representations. (1) The offeror represents as part of its offer that it is, is not a small business concern.

"Service-disabled veteran-owned small business concern"--

(i) Not less than 51 percent of which is owned by one or more service-disabled veterans or, in the case of any publicly owned business, not less than 51 percent of the stock of which is owned by one or more service-disabled veterans; and

(ii) The management and daily business operations of which are controlled by one or more service-disabled veterans or, in the case of a service-disabled veteran with permanent and severe disability, the spouse or permanent caregiver of such veteran.

(2) Service-disabled veteran means a veteran, as defined in 38 U.S.C. 101(2), with a disability that is service-connected, as defined in 38 U.S.C. 101(16).

"Small business concern" means a concern, including its affiliates, that is independently owned and operated, not dominant in the field of operation in which it is bidding on Government contracts, and qualified as a small business under the criteria in 13 CFR part 121 and the size standard in paragraph (a) of this provision.

"Veteran-owned small business concern" means a small business concern--

(1) Not less than 51 percent of which is owned by one or more veterans (as defined at 38 U.S.C. 101(2)) or, in the case of any publicly owned business, not less than 51 percent of the stock of which is owned by one or more veterans; and

(2) The management and daily business operations of which are controlled by one or more veterans.

"Women-owned small business concern" means a small business concern--

(1) That is at least 51 percent owned by one or more women; or, in the case of any publicly owned business, at least 51 percent of the stock of which is owned by one or more women; and

(2) Whose management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more women.

(d) Notice. (1) If this solicitation is for supplies and has been set aside, in whole or in part, for small business concerns, then the clause in this solicitation providing notice of the set-aside contains restrictions on the source of the end items to be furnished.

(2) Under 15 U.S.C. 645(d), any person who misrepresents a firm's status as a small, HUBZone small, small disadvantaged, or women-owned small business concern in order to obtain a contract to be awarded under the preference programs established pursuant to section 8(a), 8(d), 9, or 15 of the Small Business Act or any other provision of Federal law that specifically references section 8(d) for a definition of program eligibility, shall--

(i) Be punished by imposition of fine, imprisonment, or both;

(ii) Be subject to administrative remedies, including suspension and debarment; and

(iii) Be ineligible for participation in programs conducted under the authority of the Act.
