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**BG-8506 Cargo Valves and Expansion Joints**

BG-8506 is a liquid cargo barge, steel construction, of the U.S. Army BG-type, built by AK-WA Shipyard in Tacoma, WA, in 1990. Tanks aboard the barge are empty and relatively clean, and had been recently certified gas-free safe for hot work by a Marine Chemist in July, 2008. All work is to be accomplished at the barge's current berth alongside the Office Barge at the end of the pier at Suisun Bay Reserve Fleet, Benicia, CA.

Provide labor, material and services to free up cargo valves and renew flexible expansion joints as follows:

1. Free up six each 6" cargo valves located in the cargo tanks. Valves are frozen shut and will require disassembly in order to free them up. Disassemble in place. Polish seating surfaces, lubricate and reassemble. Exercise the valves and test for proper operation. Valves are 6" plug valves, cast steel, ASTM A-126, Class B.
2. Renew five each 8" flexible nitrile/neoprene flanged expansion joints, including backing plates. Renew fastening hardware with cadmium-plated steel 3/4"-10 unc x 3 1/2" hex head bolts, lock nuts and flat washers.
3. Conduct a 100 psi air test to assure that the valves seat and the expansion joint flanges are leak-free. Make adjustments as necessary.
4. Prior to installation, fully coat the expansion joint backing plates with two coats of surface tolerant epoxy primer if they are not suitably plated. Touch up any disturbed coatings on the valves and pipeline flanges with two coats of surface tolerant epoxy primer.
