FY07 M&R A REPAIRS -

The purpose of this project is to accomplish MARAD approved specific work items on the ship's approved business plan, as identified below. All completed work shall be in compliance with applicable standards as set forth in the Ship Manager contract at C.6.3, Compliance Documents, and subparagraphs thereto, at the time of acceptance.

Air Conditioning Motor Overhaul - Provide all labor, material and equipment to remove, overhaul, re-install AC motor and prove satisfaction operation to the CLS representative.

WO/SR: 0000352

Gland Exhaust Fan and Motor Repairs - Provide all labor, material and equipment to remove, overhaul fan and motor, re-install unit and onboard and test to the satisfaction of the CLS Representative.

WO/SR: 5100257

Fire Dampers Repairs - Provide all labor, material and equipment to recondition the ships fire damper closures. Approximately 66 closures. Repairs shall include repairing all worn door securing devices, hinge assemblies, knife-edges and gasket channels, install new gaskets and conduct a caulk test to meet all regulatory approvals.
